The children were fascinated by the pink flamingo birds and the cuckoo bird, who enjoyed being the centre of attention.



Our trip proved to be very successful as we all learnt and acquired knowledge about different birds and their habitats. The children enjoyed walking along the stream whilst watching the ducks in the small village of Bourton-on-the-Water. It was a treat to have an ice cream after a very hot day! We would also like to mention that the children were exceptionally well behaved through out the day.

We visited St. James City Farm to learn more about the different animals. The staff at the farm talked to the children about how to care and look after the animals, All children were able to touch, feed and watch the animals at the farm.





