Our focus was on patience:

- We're learnt the virtue of **patience**. How to be patient and how to take turns. We developed the ability of thinking through and resolving problems.

Teaching patience by example helps children learn resilience and self-containment.



- Gaining closeness to Our Creator: We used our I'tikaf tent as our special place for reflection and praying in Ramadan. We enjoyed crawling into the tent, being cooperative and simulated imaginative play.

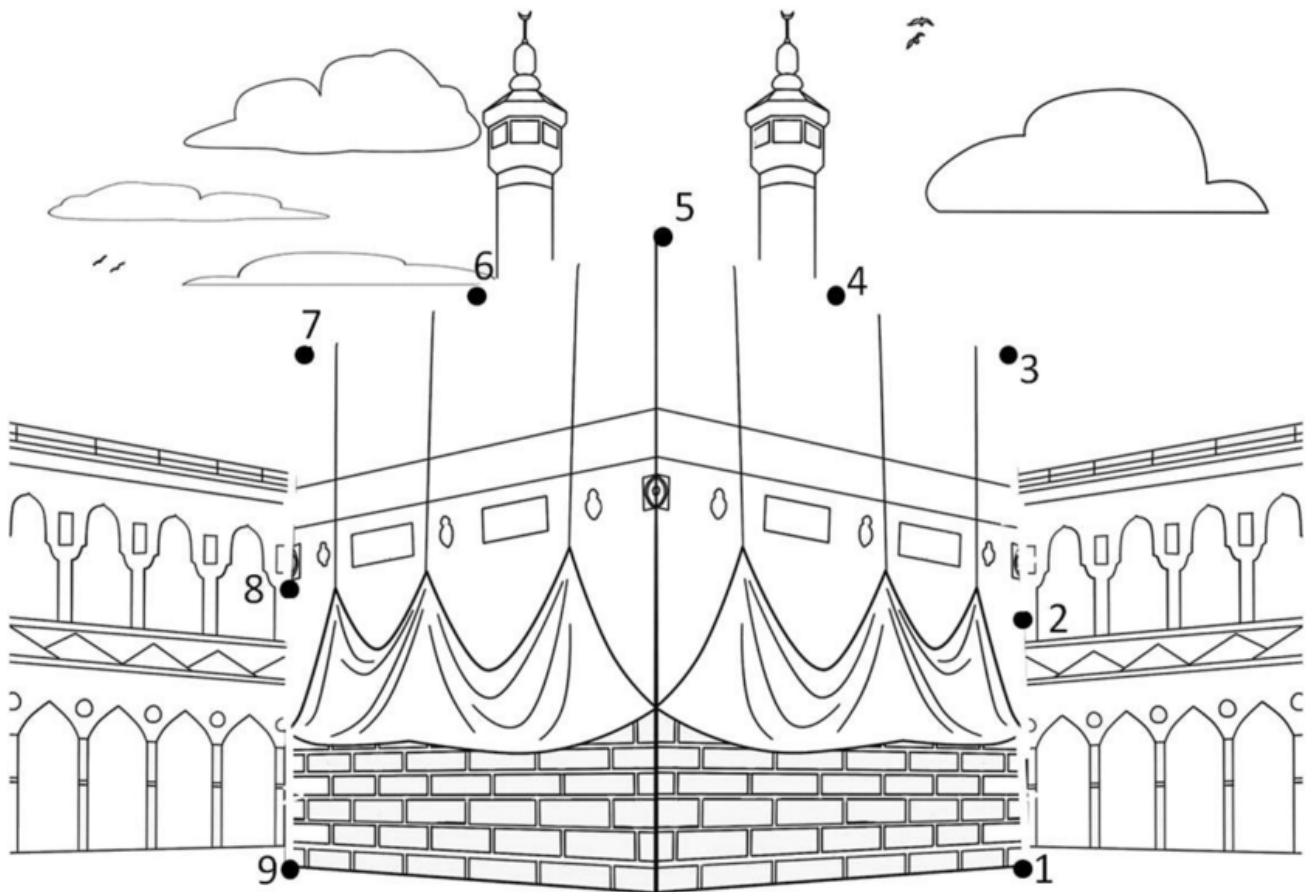
